About the Program Aide Position:

SCC is looking for enthusiastic Program Aides to join our energetic, adventurous, creative and caring staff. Applicants MUST have a love for small children (ages 2-6), animals, the outdoors, and be a team player.

Program Aides help prepare our classrooms and play yards for daily activity, as well as support our teachers with various tasks. While the role's primary functions are "behind-the-scenes" support, there are occasional opportunities to assist in the classroom and interact with students.

This position is perfect for a high school graduate considering a position in the field of Early Childhood Education, or anyone looking for a part-time, consistent schedule. The ideal candidate is friendly, supportive and professional.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Open blinds, lights on, thermostat set for opening in all classrooms
- Ensure animals are fed and water is available
- o Empty dishwasher, distribute water bottles to appropriate classrooms
- Play yard walk through opening (sweep paths and uncover furniture)
- Wipe down/disinfect picnic tables & kitchen counters (before snack, after snack, before lunch)
- o Prepare, distribute and clean up snack for all classrooms
- Maintain kitchen (keep it organized, clean & handle inventory assessment as needed)
- Weekly fridge cleanout/disinfect
- Prepare nap beds

- o Daily playground walkthrough wildlife and debris safety check (snakes, spiders, fallen branches, etc.)
- Maintain classroom art & materials closets as assigned (keep them organized & handle inventory assessment as needed)
- Water plants as needed
- Assist teachers as needed with administrative support: creating student files, prepping materials for an activity, etc.
- o Ensure restrooms are consistently clean, stocked with toilet paper/paper towels
- o Assist in general housekeeping chores (including laundry), animal care and playground upkeep
- Attend staff meetings and school events as required
- o Respond to emergency calls according to protocol
