### **About the Teacher's Assistant Position:**

SCC is looking for a qualified teacher's assistant to join our energetic, adventurous, creative and caring staff. Applicants MUST have a love for small children (ages 2-6), animals, the outdoors, and be a team player.

Teacher Assistants will work with students from all three classrooms as needed.

- Seedlings Classroom (ages 2-3... not potty trained)
- Acorns Classroom (ages 3-4)
- Pinecones Classroom (ages 4-6)

The ideal candidate is friendly, supportive and professional.

### **Responsibilities**

- Render staff support to Classroom Lead Teachers.
  - Review weekly activity plans and coordinate with Lead Teacher to determine assistance needed for each activity.
  - Set up and clean up relevant materials for activities as directed.
  - Assist with weekly inventory of student cubbies to assess for needs (diapers, wipes, extra clothes, etc.)
- Supervise nap time as scheduled.
- Supervise children on the playground and in the classroom, on hikes and on off-site field trips.
- Encourage children to interact with each other and resolve occasional arguments.
- Interact with families (signing students in and out).

- Assist children with activities of daily life (restroom use, hand washing, etc.)
- Assist with diapering, potty training and toileting.
- Maintain classroom art & materials closets as assigned (keep them organized & handle inventory assessment as needed)
- Daily playground walkthrough wildlife and debris safety check (snakes, spiders, fallen branches, etc.)
- As needed: snack time preparation, serving and lunch time setup/cleanup.
- As needed: general housekeeping chores, animal care and playground maintenance.
- Attend staff meetings, workshops and school events as required.
- Respond to emergency calls according to protocol.

- Ability to relate positively to young children, families and staff
- Strong working knowledge of Early Childhood Program Performance Standards and Nature Preschool Philosophy
- Knowledge of Reggio curriculum preferred (Emergent Curriculum)
- Effective and strong communication skills (orally and written)
- Familiarity with safety and sanitation guidelines for classrooms
- Cool-tempered, friendly and reliable
- Balance between a creative mind and practical judgement
- Ability to work in an outdoor environment that includes heat/cold, insects, reptiles and local wildlife
